ELIGIBILITY

Are you a licensed infant and toddler child care provider who accepts “Working Connections” subsidies? If so, do you fall within one of these groups?

- ◆ A provider who has not received support for consultation training services in the past year from various sources including CCR&R and regional/county health districts
- ◆ A provider who has been referred for consultation by the Department of Early Learning, child care licensing
- ◆ A provider who has not received funding for training and technical assistance through the Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS)
- ◆ A newly licensed childcare provider



HOW TO ACCESS

- ◆ *Are you looking for ideas to support your child care program?*
- ◆ *Do you wish that you had someone who could offer ideas on curriculum or guidance strategies?*
- ◆ *Do you struggle when it comes to arranging classroom and outdoor spaces?*
- ◆ *Do you have questions regarding business practices or program policies and procedures?*

FREE child care consultation is available to improve the quality of care for infants and toddlers in licensed family home and licensed child care settings in Northeast Washington.

There are multiple ways that you can access child care consultation services.

- ◆ You can contact your local Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) office.
- ◆ You can also be referred by existing community partners or through the Department of Early Learning (DEL) child care licensing.

Once you contact us, we will gather basic information from you to establish eligibility and your specific need. Then, a consultant will visit your center or family child care home to provide consultation services.

Through this project, you may be eligible for up to 10.5 hours of FREE consultation services from a local, experienced consultant.
